SALAMANCA YOUTH WRESTLING PROGRAM CODE OF CONDUCT

Dear Salamanca Youth Wrestling Parents and Children:

The Salamanca Youth Wrestling Program would like to welcome you to our new season. The program is designed to teach children respect, responsibility, discipline and sportsmanship along with team work.

Our program receives absolutely no financial support from the school systems. We rely solely on donations and volunteers; this includes the coaches that volunteer their time to teach our children. The program also encourages parents to volunteer at the meetings and at tournaments. This year, we shall hold two tournaments. Our 4th Annual Winter Warm-Up tournament will be held Saturday, January 9th, 2010 and our 15th Annual Novice Tournament will be held Sunday, January 31st, 2010. We will need approximately 50 volunteers for each of these tournaments. There will be a newsletter sent out later in December with names of who to contact if you wish to volunteer.

Each parent and child is required to follow the Salamanca Youth Wrestling Program Code of Conduct:

1. I will practice good sportsmanship.
2. I will treat others with respect.
3. I am aware that if I am disrespectful, there will be consequences for my actions.
4. I am aware that I am not to bring basketballs, footballs or any type of toys to wrestling practice.
5. I will represent the Salamanca Youth Wrestling program in a positive manner either at tournaments, at school or at home.

Parental Code of Conduct:

Practice is grueling. Tournaments take place in a hot, small gym. Your children are tired. They haven't wrestled for what seems to be hours. It is only normal that at some point in time you will find yourself frustrated. Below are some codes of conduct that the board feels will assist you when you feel that you will behave in a manner consistent within the wrestling clubs' guidelines. Please take a moment to read through them. If you should have any questions you are encouraged to ask a member of the Salamanca Youth Wrestling Club board, or a member of the coaching staff.

- Unless you are a coach, an assistant coach, or a wrestler, you are not to be on the mats.
- Any person on the mat is to have wrestling shoes on.
- Let the coaches' coach. When parents are talking, yelling or playing with their children it takes away their attention from the coach. This will not be tolerated.
- If you have a complaint or have any concerns, either about a coach or another wrestler, please see the Parent Advisor. That is what they are there for.
- Kids are encouraged to practice at home, practice with them.
- When at tournaments, sportsmanship is expected of your children. Set a good example. There will be no swearing, no yelling at a referee or a tournament host, and please do not yell at your children after losing a match. If a coach feels wronged by a ref or tournament host, *let them handle it*. If your child did not do their best the coach will handle that too. You are here to support your children.
- Kids will be taught the fundamentals of wrestling to include sportsmanship, respect, and discipline... Let the coach do this. There is a reason. If you feel your child is being wronged by the coach please address the coach or the Parent Advisor in a private setting.
- There will be no toys permitted at practice. Do not allow your children to bring toys. If there is a game, the coach or assistants will have the needed equipment.
- The board encourages all parents to come to meetings, volunteer at fundraisers and tournaments.
- If you are unable to be at practice please be prompt picking up your child. If you are unable to pick up your child make sure other arrangements are made.
